### **e-ISuite Enterprise Version 1.00.01**

(No Installation Necessary)

The e-ISuite Enterprise System is hosted on the USFS Fire and Aviation Management National Enterprise Support System (NESS) General Support System (GSS) at the National Information Technology Center (NITC), Kansas City, MO and will support all incidents at an Enterprise level.

## e-ISuite Site Production Version 1.00.01

The e-ISuite Incident Site version is hosted on a local server; very similar to how legacy I-Suite is managed today. It only requires the software to be installed on the Server machine. Clients will access the application through their local browser. ### Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 1.00.01 Full Release

- Uninstall all previous versions of e-ISuite Site.  
*Note: If upgrading from 1.00.00, see Patch information below.*
- System Requirements
  - Windows 7 Professional or Windows 2003/2008/2012 Server  
*Will install and run on Windows XP, but is not a supported operating system*
  - No competing http Services (Tomcat6 will provide web services on server machine)
  - Must have Visual C++ 2010 Runtime Redistributable installed
- Browser Requirements
  - Internet Explorer 11 Officially Supported
  - Pop-up Blockers Turned Off
  - Latest Adobe Flash Installed
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.  
*Note: For installation on Forest Service agency machines refer to the agency's PowerBroker installation procedures located on the Forest Service CIO home page.*

### Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 1.00.01 Patch

- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Version 1.00.00 Production or Training.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.

- It may be necessary to Refresh or Clear your Browser Cache before the home page displays the correct version of 1.00.01.
